SECTION 4: First aid measures

4.1. Description of first aid measures

First-aid measures general	: Call a doctor immediately, even if there are no immediate symptoms. First aid personnel must use Personal Protection Measures as indicated in section 7. . REMARK: the effect of HF and the emerging of pain can occur, particularly in case of diluted concentrations, up to 24 hours after exposure. It is important that the employees inside and outside the workplace have access to an antidote (Calcium gluconate) and can apply this as soon as possible. Inform the employee that in case of splashes in the eyes no gel should be applied and that a physician should be consulted.
First-aid measures after inhalation	: Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing. Induce artificial respiration with mask fitted with one-way valve or other suitable device; not mouth-to-mouth. Call a physician.

In case of skin contact, wearing rubber gloves rub 2.5% calcium gluconate gel continuously into the affected area for 1.5 hours or until further medical care is available.

First-aid measures after ingestion	: Rinse mouth. Call a physician immediately. Do not induce vomiting.
First-aid measures for first aider	: First aid workers will be equipped with suitable personal protective equipment.

4.2. Most important symptoms and effects, both acute and delayed

Symptoms/effects after inhalation	: None under normal conditions. The material produces irritation of the respiratory system in a substantial number of individuals following inhalation.
Symptoms/effects after skin contact	: Fatal in contact with skin. Burns.
Symptoms/effects after eye contact	: Serious damage to eyes.
Symptoms/effects after ingestion	: Toxic if swallowed. Burns.
Chronic symptoms	: Hydrogen fluoride easily penetrates the skin and causes destruction and corrosion of the bone and underlying tissue. Ingestion causes severe pains and burns in the mouth and throat and blood calcium levels are dangerously reduced. Symptoms include spasm and twitching of the muscles, high fever, convulsions and general extreme pain. Inhalation may cause corrosion of the throat, nose and lungs, leading to severe inflammation and lung swelling.

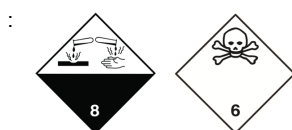

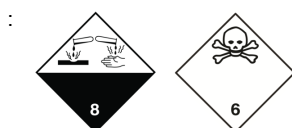
